

The Final Pediment Stone is Laid at William Wake House

At a topping out ceremony last week the final pediment stone was laid at our £46 million Residential Mental Health Facility in Northampton for St Andrews Healthcare.

The vast amount of stone required for this huge project can be seen from the statistics below

- **6950 tonnes** supplied for the scheme
- **4760 individual stones** had to be cut for the whole scheme
- **159 stones** cut per week
- 3 stones fit on one pallet requiring **1587 pallets** to be delivered to site

The topping out ceremony was attended by GB staff and Stonewest Ltd the stonemasons for the scheme.

When the building is completed in October 2010 it will be billed as 'The country's biggest classical new-build project for half a century'.
